**As ENGAGING and ACTIVE as possible.**

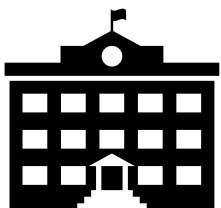
#### ASYNCHRONOUS LEARNING TIME



- Outside of *Synchronous Instruction Time*
- Students can call in during office hours
- Students work independently
- **Numbers** document accessible via **Schoology**
  
- Instruction could include, but is not limited to:
  - Instructional videos
  - Recorded lectures
  - Assigned reading
  - Note taking
  - Independent practice
  - Other assignments designated by the teacher
